



Curriculum Guide

Here is a short summary of the curriculum your child will be following this half term.
You can help by:

- Sharing a book with your child each day
- Helping your child with their learn by heart target or multiplication tables
- Speaking to your child about their work and day at school
- Making sure they have the right equipment for school
- Checking their homework diary each week

Reading	<p>This half term, we will be exploring and developing our understanding of the Roman times. We will be reading a fiction text called 'The Goose Guards', We will be retrieving information from the text to answer retrieval comprehension questions. The children will be able to sequence a story, skim, scan and infer the characters feelings and emotions by looking at the evidence from the text. Our class novel is Mr Stink. We will be reading the book and using it to develop our reading fluency.</p>	
Writing	<p>In writing, children will consolidate their understanding of prepositions, expanded noun phrases, subordinating conjunctions and using paragraphs. We will be looking at creating our own short stories and the children will be planning, writing and editing these, The children will be writing their own ending to 'The Goose Guards' story.</p>	
Mathematics	<p>This half term, children we will be further developing their understanding of arithmetic skills and how to apply new methods they have learnt in Year 3. They will be learning about time, capacity and mass and how to estimate. The children will also focus on being resilient when using all of the year 3 problem solving strategies.</p>	<p>Learn By Heart Targets: 3 times table division facts $12 \div 3 = 4$ $27 \div 3 = 9$ $33 \div 3 = 11$ 4 times table division facts $24 \div 4 = 6$ $40 \div 4 = 10$ $16 \div 4 = 4$</p>
Creative Curriculum	<p>Our topic this half term is called "Emperors and Empires". In this topic, we will look at the Ancient Romans. The children will explore the Roman empire and their hierarchy. The will research and explore everyday life in the Roman times. We will also explore why the Romans invaded England and how they were successful. Year 3 will gather information and come to their own conclusion on the significance of the Romans invasion. We will also compare this time with other periods of history we have learnt about and how they were different and similar. In addition to history, we will also be learning about plants and nutrition in science.</p>	
Physical Education	<p>It is a very exciting half term for children in year 3, an English Cricket Board (ECB) coach is coming into school to teach Chance to Shine cricket. Children will develop personal, social and physical skills whilst enhancing their cricket skills. Dodgeball will also be taught to further develop the children's knowledge of invasion games and to outwit their opponents. There will be an intra - school house point dodgeball competition this half term, to help develop healthy attitudes to winning and losing.</p>
