

KS1 Hub Curriculum Guide

Here is a short summary of the curriculum your child will be following this half term.

You can help by;

- Sharing a book with your child each day
- Helping your child with their learn by heart target and guided reading.
- Speaking to your child about their work and day at school
- Making sure they have the right equipment for school

English	This half term the children in the hub will be reading a fiction story 'On the Way Home' and 'George and the Dragon'. They will learn new vocabulary, listen and write the sounds in these new words and sequence the story, the children will use these skills learnt to role play the story. They will create and design different props to accompany their story telling. In speaking and listening they will continue with colourful semantics to help form fluent sentences when speaking. Colourful semantics will also be used to help build sentences when writing simple sentences. The children will continue to write simple sentences and captions for pictures. Our Lego therapy sessions will continue, to help with communication and attention.	
Maths	We will be singing number rhymes and practice counting forwards and backwards to and from 20. Children will subitise to 5 and continue to carefully count amounts to 10, matching it to the numeral. As well as representir numbers in many different ways as possible such as tallies, pictures and numicon. They will learn the number pairs and fact families to 10 and tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.	
Phonics	In phonics the children are learning phase 3 sounds and phase 4 CVCC and CCVC words with long vowel sounds. For letter formation practice we will be practicing the sounds we have learnt that week in our handwriting books each day. Guided Reading sessions are to continue daily. Once a week, a one to one reading session and catch up phonics, to support those needing more practice has been added to our timetable.	
Creative Curriculum	In art and design we will be learning all about still life paintings and famous artists. We will sketch observational drawings, learn how to mix colours and then use our skills to create our own still life painting. In design technology, we will be making our own picture frames out of wood. We will investigate ways to make structures stronger and more stable and also find out about the best ways to join materials. In music we will be continuing to play the glockenspiel and in science we will be finding out more about animals and their habitats.	
Physical Education	In P.E. this half term, children in year 1 will be enhancing their skills in basic game-playing, in particular throwing and catching to further develop their hand – eye coordination. Year 1 children will also be taking part in athletic and fitness activities to strengthen their knowledge of team participation, explore different techniques, speeds and effort to meet challenges set for running, jumping and throwing.
