



Curriculum Guide

Here is a short summary of the curriculum your child will be following this half term.
You can help by:

- Sharing a book with your child each day
- Helping your child with their learn by heart target or multiplication tables
- Speaking to your child about their work and day at school
- Making sure they have the right equipment for school
- Checking their homework diary each week

Reading	In reading, we will explore our new class novel book called "Beast Quest". We will use this book to work on our comprehension skills such as retrieval and inference and we will also look at reading parts of the book to improve our reading fluency. We will read the book "The King who banned the dark". We will be reading detectives and look for clues in the book about how the characters are feeling.	
Writing	This half term, we will be look at applying all of the Year Three writing skills that we have learnt. We will be creating our own version of the story "the king who banned the dark". We will create our own story mountain to help us plan it and write our finished version in our publishing books. We are also going to create our own Roman non-fiction book. Our book will showcase all of our writing skills as well as all of the knowledge we have learnt about the Romans.	
Mathematics	<p>This half term, we will revisit our learning on fractions and learn about equivalent fractions. We will look at angles in a turn and how we can find them in different 2D shapes.</p> <p>In our problem solving lesson, we will practice all the different types of problem solving strategies we have learnt in Year 3, these include drawing a diagram, trial and improvement, using a table or list and act it out.</p>	<p>Learn By Heart Targets:</p> <p>This half term we will be mixing up all the times tables we have learnt.</p> <p>3, 4, 6 and 8 times table.</p>
Creative Curriculum	Our topic this half term is called "Emperors and Empires". In this topic, we will continue to look at the Ancient Romans. We will also explore why the Romans invaded England and how they were successful. Year Three will gather information and come to their own conclusion on the significance of the Roman's invasion. We will also compare this time with other periods of history we have learnt about and how they were different and similar. Our last topic for Year Three is 'light and dark' in science. We will explore how shadows are formed and how they change shape. We will explore opaque and transparent objects and how they impact shadows. We will do this through a variety of experiments.	
Physical Education	In P.E. this half term, children in year 3 will be further developing their hand - eye coordination through the game of tennis as well as exploring how to score points through basic game-playing tactics. In addition, children will be participating in athletics and fitness activities to strengthen their knowledge of team participation. This in turn, will increase their understanding of using different techniques for speed and distance.
