English As readers we will: • use and understand recently introduced vocabulary during discussions about stories, non-fiction and during role-play • read words ending with -s and -es • read some common exception and taught words • recite a simple four-line rhyme or verse by heart As writers we will: • make up our own phrases or short sentences with a subject and a verb to express our thoughts aloud about stories and experiences • use the connective 'and' to link two words or ideas in a sentence • punctuate with exclamation marks with support Maths As mathematicians we will learn about: • Time - tell the time to the hour and half hour on an analogue clock, and read hours and half hours on a digital clock	English As readers we will: • answer a range of questions linked to our reading books • identify and read words we know in our reading books • use the sounds we know to help us read new words and / or practise reading whole words on sight • use dictionaries to help us find new words and what they mean As writers we will: • plan and write reports about sea creatures • punctuate all sentences with a capital and full stop • begin to use question marks and exclamation marks • segment and spell words correctly in sentences Maths As mathematicians we will learn about: • Fractions – finding halves/quarters of shapes and numbers • Measures – Mass/weight: measuring in grams and kilograms; learn to read scales	English As readers we will: • Discuss and describe characters and settings • Recite short poems with appropriate expression and intonation • Continue to develop our comprehension skills through discussion and role play As writers we will: • Use adjectives and/or adverbs in our writing • Write speech bubbles or dialogue • Describe characters Maths As mathematicians we will learn about: • Time • Position and direction • Revision of maths we have learned throughout the year
